

2026 Local League Rules

District 30/38/46/55/56/62/68 – Juniors

The Little League rule book/app will govern all games for 2026 regular season. The rules listed below are in addition to the rule book.

- 1) Each manager/team must carry a roster and pitching affidavit to be filled out by the scorekeeper at each game. Scorekeepers may use Game Changer but affidavits MUST be utilized and filled out after each game. Game Changer is NOT an approved pitch count verification (affidavit).
- 2) Minimum play is 3 innings per game. If a player does not receive their minimum play they must start the next game and play the remaining innings and the required innings before being removed from the game. Mercy eliminates minimum play requirement. Innings do NOT need to be consecutive.
- 3) No new inning after 2:15. A new inning is considered as soon as 3rd out made in bottom of previous inning. If the game is called due to permit time/Light or Act of God then game will revert back to the last completed inning unless the home team is ahead. ALL pitches thrown count and must be recorded on affidavit!
- 4) Games must complete at least 5 innings (4 ½ if home team head) unless the mercy rule is attained. Any game not completing the minimum innings played will not count in the standings. Tie games will be counted in the standings but will count the same as a loss in computing the win percentage.
- 5) Districts governing committee (DA or ADA Reps) has authority to forfeit a game. If an umpire suspends a game it is to be reported to Kent Dodson who will consult the committee for decision.
- 6) Home Team (NOT HOST) is responsible for supplying umpire regardless of the field you are playing at.

- 7) Home Team is responsible for supplying a scorekeeper for each game. 20 minutes prior to game time each manager must submit their line up, pitching affidavit and roster to the official scorekeeper. Keep all affidavits.
- 8) Each team supplies 2 new balls for each game. If others are needed each team will take turns supplying gently used balls beginning with the home team.
- 9) ALL scores must be emailed to admin@cadist30-Juniors.org or text to 661-714-8730 (Kent) & 714-814-6595 (Chuck) immediately after the game! Report Date, Time, Location, Teams, score, innings played.
- 10) League age 15 may play juniors but cannot pitch.

- 7.1 **Waldron Field** – Santiago Middle School
515 N. Rancho Santiago Boulevard, Orange
 - 7.1.1 No home run fence, runner must leg out home run
 - 7.1.2 Backstop fence line determines field of play.
- 7.2 **Memorial Park** – 2102 S. Flower Street, Santa Ana
 - 7.2.1 Backstop fence determines field of play
 - 7.2.2 All light and goal posts are in play
 - 7.2.3 No home run fence, runner must leg out home run
- 7.3 **Johnson Middle School** – 13603 Edwards St. Westminster
 - 7.3.1 Left/Centerfield no home Run Fence, runner must leg out home run
 - 7.3.2 Right Field Home Run Fence 400 ft
 - 7.3.3 Concrete on left field is foul ball
